





TICKET EXCHANGES

Season Ticket holders are welcome to exchange tickets free of charge up to 24 hours prior to performance. A \$5 service fee applies within 24 hours of showtime. All others may exchange tickets up to 72 hours prior to the performance only. There is a \$5 per ticket service fee for exchanged tickets, up to \$20.

If you are not able to use your tickets for a production and are unable to find an exchange date, please pass them along to someone who can attend. There are no refunds on unused portions of season subscriptions.

All tickets reserved over the internet are final. No exchanges can be made.

PERFORMANCE ETIQUETTE

Cell phones and pagers must be turned off or set to vibrate only during performances. You may check them at the Box Office prior to curtain time, if desired.

Photography (with or without flash) and recording devices of any kind (audio or video) are not to be used during performances.

Unless otherwise specified, children must be at least five years old to attend SCT performances. Children ages three and older are welcome to *Beauty and the Beast*, *Annie*, and CTA shows provided they have a ticket (no infants, please).


