Students please arrive one hour (this is referred to as “call time”) before the performance starts and enter AND exit through Stage Door 1 (the door that leads directly backstage).

Students may not leave until the entire show is over, so that they can participate in bows and finale number.

General Information: For hair and make-up questions, please ask your teacher. To help with the whole process please arrive at your scheduled time in costume and make-up, ready to go. If you would like to get ready at the theatre, come earlier than your scheduled “call time.” Remember: all students should enter and exit through Stage Door 1. Strike (cleaning up and removing all personal items) is required after all performances from all participants.

Flash photography will not be allowed during the dress rehearsals or performance. You may take pictures and film DURING DRESS REHEARSAL ONLY as long as you stay behind the designated photographer’s area. We will have photographers at the final dress rehearsal. To order a CD of photographs, please fill out the order form that is located near the box office and submit to Shannon or photographer directly. Do not give this form to the box office.

Videography of the performances will be done by Devin Frederking. We will have forms for you to order the video of your child’s performance directly from him. Prices will be determined for photos and video by these contractors.

Each student will receive ONE ticket per student per performance they are in. So, if you have one child that is in two performances, you will receive a total of two comp tickets. If you have two children, but they are in the same performance, you will receive 2 comp tickets. If you have one child performing in Friday’s show, and one child performing in both shows on Saturday, you will receive 3 total comp tickets. Some students are performing in more than one performance, and some are not. Consult your teacher with questions about whether or not your student is in more than one performance. If you have questions, please ask Shannon (785-827-6126 or shannon@salinatheatre.com). Comp tickets are only available to those students whose bill is paid in full.

Tickets are \$10 for adults and \$5 for students, plus tax. ALL TICKETS MUST BE RESERVED (EVEN COMP TICKETS). Call or visit the box office M-F between 11:30am and 4:00pm to reserve your tickets.

All students need to plan to bring their YELLOW CTA T-Shirt to wear for our “Finale/Bows.”
