Then it grew again, doubling in size, with the ability to entertain at so many levels. And now, education is exploding, evolving the organization forward in areas it didn't imagine before.



CENTER FOR THEATRE ARTS

Center for Theatre Arts is the educational wing of Theatre Salina, offering a variety of classes and camps to students pre-kindergarten through adult. CTA is the only academy between Topeka and Denver providing year-round educational and performance opportunities for young artists.

The success of the CTA program is evidenced by the number of graduates who have gone on to theatre arts-related careers. Of course, not all students become stars, but each student can have an enriching experience by learning to sing, dance, and act in CTA classes.

Each season, CTA offers at least five opportunities for students to gain performance experience: **FALL SHOW • SPRING SHOW • CENTERSTAGE SUMMERSTAGE • STAGE II**

Nearly 400 students register for CTA activities each season. A large percentage attend on partial or full scholarships, and no child is turned away for an inability to pay.

How to make reservations

Select the performance, date, and seats by calling the box office at 785.827.3033, coming by 303 E. Iron Ave, or visiting salinatheatre.com. For convenience: full season ticket holders can also make their reservations online.

* If you are a season ticket holder, please have your member ID ready.

Ticket exchanges & policies

Season Ticket holders are welcome to exchange tickets free of charge up to 24 hours prior to performance. To exchange, please call the box office. **(A \$5 service fee applies within 24 hours of showtime.)**

Purchased tickets may be exchanged up to 72 hours prior to the performance. There is a \$5 per ticket service fee for exchanged tickets, up to \$20.

If you are not able to use your tickets for a production and are unable to find an exchange date, please pass them along to someone who can attend. There are no refunds or doubling up on shows for unused portions of season subscriptions.

All tickets reserved online are final. No exchanges can be made.

Unless otherwise specified, children must be at least five years old to attend Theatre Salina performances. Children ages three and older are welcome to *The Addams Family: A New Musical*, *A Christmas Story: The Musical*, and *School of Rock! The Musical* and CTA shows, provided they have a ticket (no infants, please).

Performance etiquette

Cell phones and pagers must be turned off or set to vibrate only during performances. Please turn your smart watch to "Theatre Mode". You may check them at the Box Office prior to curtain time, if desired.

Photography (with or without flash) and recording devices of any kind (audio or video) or electronic devices are not to be used during performances.



AUDITIONS

WHAT TO EXPECT: Doors open 30 minutes ahead of the scheduled audition time to fill out audition forms. For MainStage productions: scripts for upcoming productions can be checked out at our Box Office for perusal (\$10 deposit).

MAINSTAGE MUSICALS: Please prepare a song choice of around one minute in the style of the show. An accompanist will be provided as well as an auxiliary line for electronic devices. No acapella singing please. Audition song must be memorized and performers must be prepared to learn choreography from the show. You may also be asked to read scenes from the show with scripts provided at the audition.

MAINSTAGE PLAYS: Be prepared to read from the script provided at auditions.
